Who Can Get Help?



Children

Children can often get health care, (including regular check-ups) depending on their age and how much money their parents make:

- For free from Medi-Cal
- At a low-cost from the Healthy Families Program or other programs

Pregnant Women

Pregnant women can often get free, or low cost, health care through **Medi-Cal** or **AIM** (Access for Infants and Mothers), depending on their income.



Other Adults

Medi-Cal also covers:

- Parents who make little money
- Some people with very bad health problems
- Some people with large medical bills
- Many families who move from welfare to work

The County

The county helps other people who make very little money and have no insurance. Call us for more information.
