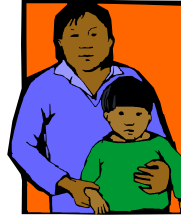


Many legal immigrants can get regular Medi-Cal or Healthy Families

These programs cover most health care — like doctors, hospitals, medicine and shots.

You can get regular **Medi-Cal** if:

- ▶ You have low income and
- ▶ You are a child, a parent, pregnant, elderly, a person with disabilities, or a relative caring for a child and
- ▶ You live in California and plan to stay and
- ▶ You are in the U.S. legally or the INS knows you are in the U.S. and is not trying to deport you. For example, you might have a green card or be a refugee. Some battered women and children can also get Medi-Cal.



Healthy Families covers U.S. citizen children and legal immigrant children with family incomes too high for free Medi-Cal.
